Subject: Alignment of Trade License Number and CDB number for e-GP Access

This is to inform all contractors that in order to maintain seamless access to your track record through the electronic Government Procurement (e-GP), it is mandatory to retain the same **Trade License Number** when your deregistered Construction Development Board (CDB) number is reissued upon renewal by the Bhutan Construction and Transport Authority (BCTA).

Therefore, all contractors must ensure that your Trade License Number remains consistent with the one previously registered in the e-GP when renewing your deregistered CDB number to avoid disruptions in accessing the e-GP.

Failure to retain the same Trade License Number may result in challenges or denial of access to the e-GP system, which is used for government procurement processes.
